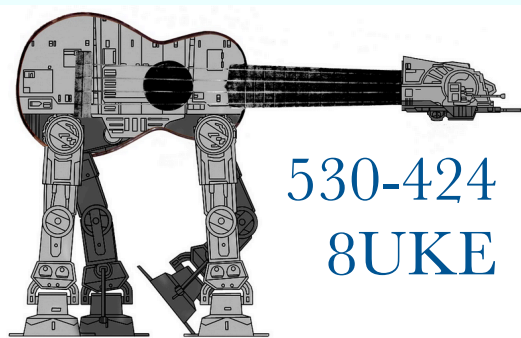
Here in Chico, she has worked with ChiChiUG- Chico Children's Uke Group, and Uke Crazy, a youth Uke Ensemble.

Session 1: *JUNE 20 - 24*

10:05am - 10:50am

Ukulele Jump Start

1.0 is for total beginners and those who have yet to master switching between chords in the key of C. (C, Am, F, and G.) If you're brand new to ukulele, join us!

11:05am - 11:50am

Jump Start 2.0 is for those who know how to get to and from C, F, G, and Am, but have yet to explore outside of the key of C. We will play and sing in the keys of D and G, and learn how to read and play the pentatonic scale!

12:05pm - 12:50pm

Jam Practice

Already comfortable with chords but not sure how to make the leap into melody picking and soloing? Using simple scale patterns we will pick and play both newgrass and modern songs. We will also develop short melodic riffs and practice taking breaks!

Session 2: *JUNE 27 - JULY 1*

Sounds of Hawai'i - (all levels)

expand your cultural repertoire with beautiful songs in the Hawai'ian language, and other 'hapa-haole' songs that mix English and Hawai'ian.

Strum Theory: (all levels)

Comfortable with chords and ready to work on your right hand? We will explore strumming techniques from straight eights through chunking, flicking, and pulling to create unique sounds that can enhance the rhythm of all your favorite songs!

12:05pm - 12:55pm

Fun with Fundamentals: Reading Music on Ukulele (all levels)

Want to play the theme from Star Wars? A classical or modern orchestral arrangement? Translate the songs you know to other instruments? It all starts with learning to read music. Students benefit from the additional listening and rhythm skills necessary to play well in a group setting. We'll start with the basics in the key of C and move as quickly as the class allows!

Session 3: *AUGUST 8 - 12*

Newgrass Ukulele (beginner through intermediate levels)

Have a good old fashioned time with old-time and bluegrass traditionals. These three chord songs will build your repertoire and help you recognize chord progressions - the patterns within the music that you play. Jam Practicers also encouraged to practice their break-taking skills!

11:05am - 11:50am

Intermediate Topics:

Intermediate students should have a comfortable grasp of the keys of C, D, G and A, and also have *started* their Bb chord. Topics will include two of the following: Intro to Barre Chords, Chord melody, 7th chords, Scales, Chord families and Transposition

12:05pm - 12:55pm

Reading and Rhythm Ukulele

Band: Beginning and intermediate music readers will learn arrangements of classical, modern, and popular music to perform later in August!

All groups require a minimum of four registered students to stay on the schedule. If more than 8 students register for a given class, a wait list will be created.

Rates: Each class fee is \$60 per student per session. Private students that are fully enrolled for the month of June (for June sessions) or August (for August sessions) are encouraged to join the Jam Practice camp and Reading and Rhythm camp for the low additional fee of \$10 per student per session.
